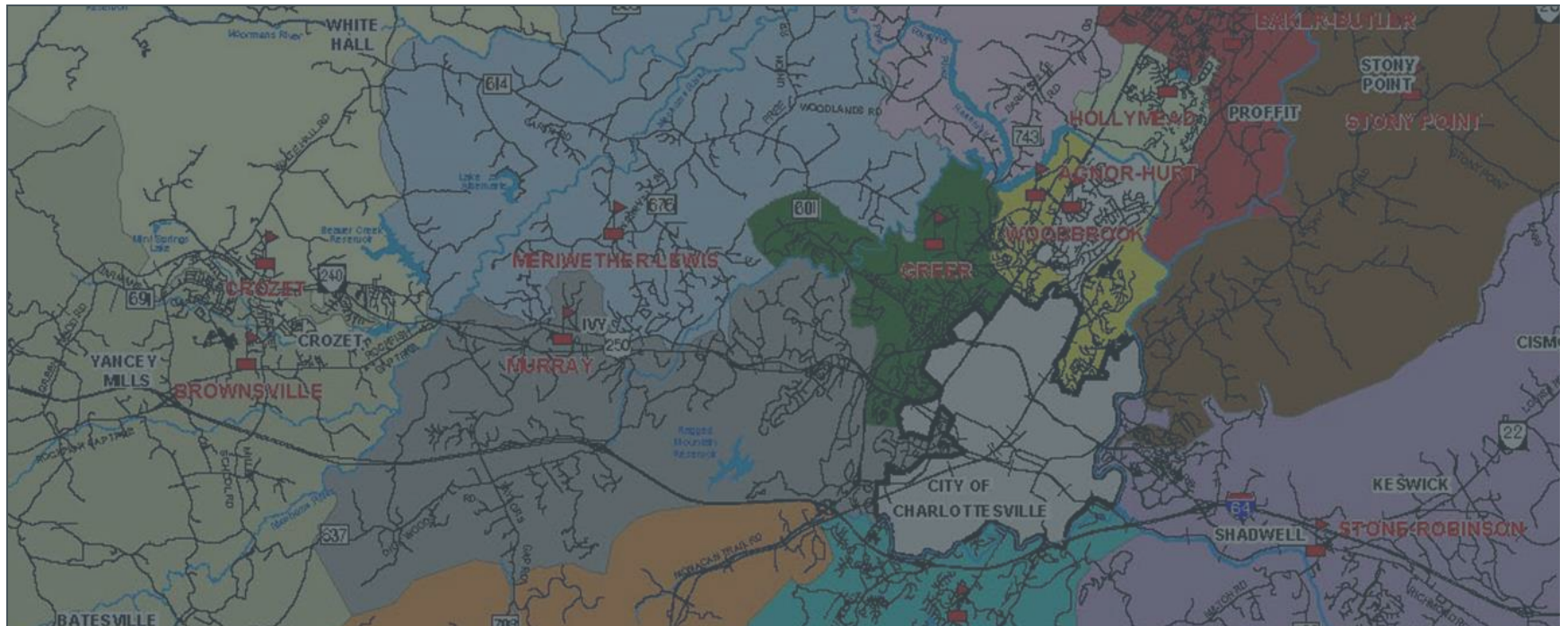

CAPACITY VS. ENROLLMENT

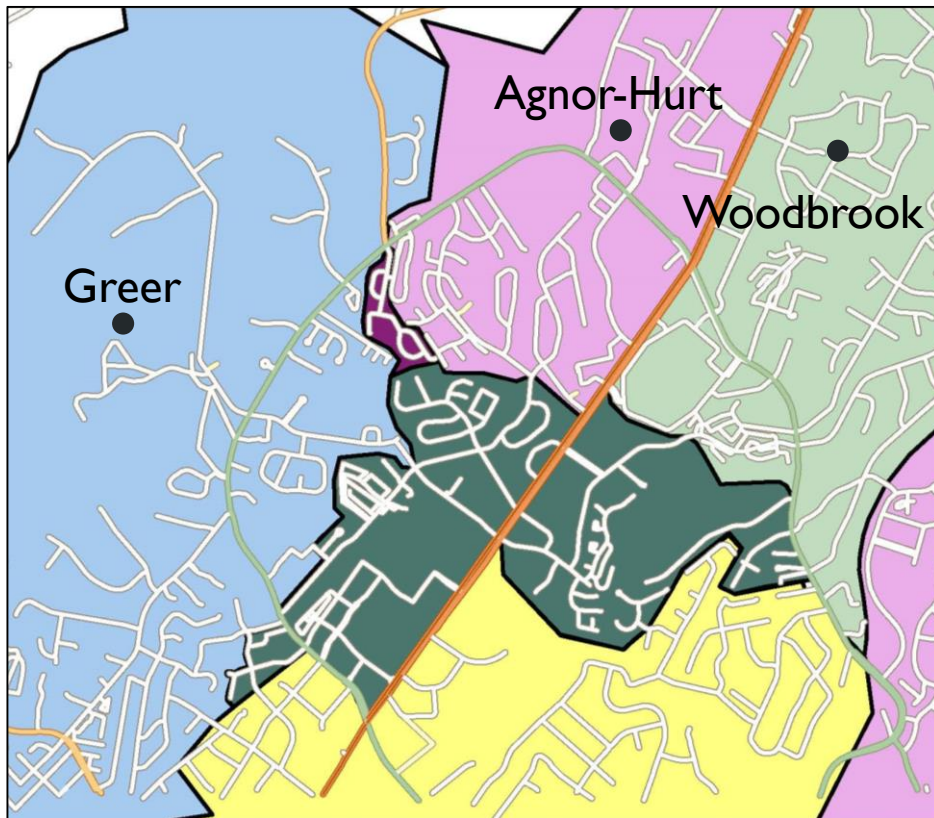

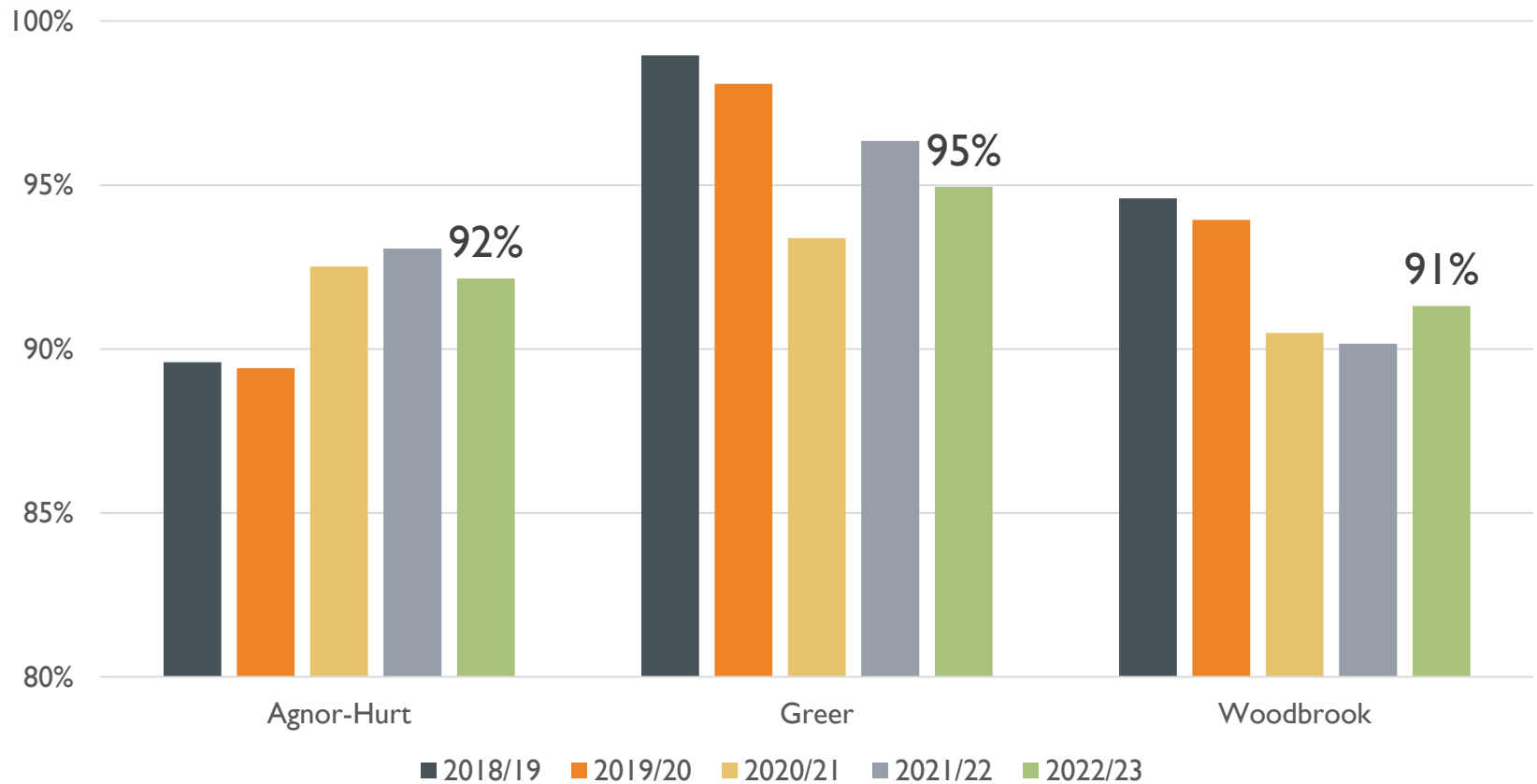

MIDDLE SCHOOL IMPACTS

NO CHANGE

- Areas redistricted from Greer to Woodbrook would remain at Jouett.
- Areas redistricted from Greer to Agnor-Hurt would also remain at Jouett. This would increase the portion of Agnor-Hurt that attends Jouett from 13% to 22%.

CHANGE

- Areas redistricted from Agnor-Hurt to Woodbrook would be redistricted from Burley to Jouett to prevent a split at Woodbrook. There are currently 26 middle school students in that area. Jouett has the capacity to receive that amount.
 - Minor Ridge
 - Branchlands
 - Rio Road –Wakefield to Pine Haven

GRANDFATHER CLAUSE: PAST EXAMPLES

2013

- All rising fifth graders and their siblings are permitted to remain at Agnor-Hurt for one more year, but they must provide their own transportation or use an existing Agnor-Hurt bus stop if bus capacity is available.
- All rising sixth, seventh and eighth grade students from Northfield/Huntington are permitted to remain at Burley Middle School until they complete middle school, but they must provide their own transportation or use an existing Burley bus stop if capacity allows.

2012

- A "grandfather privilege" was extended for families of rising 5th graders and their siblings who are currently enrolled at Hollymead to stay at Hollymead through 5th grade.
