CLEAR ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF TEAM MEMBERS


In being familiar with roles and responsibilities of other team members, responses to ideas and suggestions can be on a more positive note.

Clearly Define Roles



OPEN COMMUNICATIONS

Open communication creates and maintains a climate of trust and honesty. Open communication allows team members to talk openly with one another, it promotes the exchange of feedback and provides each team member the ability to work through misunderstanding and conflicts.



SOLVING THE PROBLEM

Each team member should have the opportunity to state their views and to do so in a clear and non-judgmental language while other members listen carefully to each person's point of view.

NEGOTIATING CONFLICT

Negotiating conflicts gets to the heart of problem solving and takes a look at the underlying needs of the problem(s).



STRATEGY
