C-40: Students Transporting Personal Belongings

As stated in the "Parent's Guide to Transportation," any object that is to be transported on a school bus must be able to be held in the student's lap. The aisles on the buses may not be blocked under any circumstances nor may there be objects on the bus that are not secured. Examples of items allowed on the bus include: baseball bats, field hockey sticks, lacrosse sticks, medium-sized or smaller musical instruments, fishing poles without hooks, and skate boards. Items not allowed on the bus include balloons, large musical instruments, glass objects or containers not stores in the backpack. An accommodation may be made for larger items if another student is not sharing the seat. The item must be in the student's control at all times.
