Pathway to U.S. Citizenship

For an adult immigrant to become a U.S. citizen, he or she must go through the process of naturalization. GENERAL requirements for naturalization call for the immigrant to:

Naturalization (Form N-400) Take an oath of Be a lawfully admitted permanent allegiance to the resident of the United States **United States Demonstrate a basic knowledge** of U.S. history, government, and civic principles (million) TILLAND At the time of filing the application, have been a permanent resident in the **United States for at least 5** years (or for at least **3** years if you meet all eligibility requirements **Demonstrate an ability to** to file as a spouse of a read, write, speak, and **United States citizen)** understand basic English

Be at least 18 years old at the time

of filing the Application for



Have lived within the State or USCIS District for at least 3 months prior to filing
