K-1 Book Closet: We're requesting a volunteer to help maintain and organize the K-1 Book Closet. This is a very flexible job that you can do on your own time.

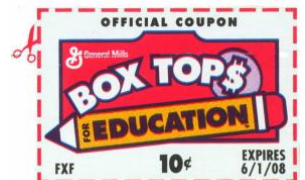
