STUDENT PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT

Students are assigned to the ENTERPRISE CENTER by the Albemarle County Schools for a variety of reasons. It is of the utmost importance that students entering this program realize that the major emphasis of their attendance here is to allow them the OPPORTUNITY to change BEHAVIORS and ATTITUDES that have been hindering them in the regular school setting.

Each student will be asked to work on a behavioral and instructional plan that is developed and designed to address his/her specific needs. Students entering the program must develop the understanding that mutual respect with others and the acceptance of personal responsibility are expected.

Changing BEHAVIORAL patterns and learning new coping skills requires effort and cooperation. We ask that each student come to the ENTERPRISE CENTER with the willingness to give change a chance to happen by being open to learning new skills that will provide better opportunities in future educational settings.

ALL STUDENTS ATTENDING THE ENTERPRISE CENTER WILL:

- Follow an individualized instructional and behavioral plan that the student will develop along with program instructors based on input from the base schools.
- Comply with all bus and transportation guidelines. This includes the restriction that the individual will only be allowed to be in designated areas at the base schools to catch the shuttle bus to the Enterprise Center. ENTERPRISE STUDENTS will not otherwise be allowed on base school property unless they have been given permission from school administration.

- Follow the conditions for acceptable student behavior as set forth in the CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALBEMARLE COUNTY SCHOOLS as well as regulations particular to the ENTERPRISE CENTER. These regulations will include, but are not limited to:
 1. Respect of persons and property
 2. Attendance on a regular basis
 3. Participation in assigned learning opportunities designed by instructors
 4. The avoidance of the use of profanity and other abusive language
 5. Threats to staff or others will not be tolerated. References to weapons, violence, gangs and alcohol, tobacco and drug use will result in immediate sanctions and possible removal from the program
 6. Students will be asked to pass through a metal detector upon arrival to THE ENTERPRISE CENTER. All electronic devices such as cell phones, IPODS, CD players or other personal electronic devices will be left with EC staff each morning.
 7. Students will strictly adhere to the COMPUTER USAGE GUIDELINES that will be outlined to them by the ENTERPRISE CENTER instructional staff. Students will not damage or misuse any Albemarle County instructional and electronic equipment. Students in violation may be subject to suspension or removal from the program.
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My signature on this document indicates that I have read, understood and agreed to comply with the conditions outlined above. I also understand that violations of this agreement may result in sanctions from the ENTERPRISE CENTER that may include suspension and/or referral to the county Hearing Officer.

It is also understood that by signing this contract, the PARENTS/GUARDIENS of the student understand the regulations outlined and possible sanctions so that the program can work with the student and family to ensure academic and behavioral success.
