

# **1<sup>st</sup> Annual Walton Math Tournament**

### **Divisions for grades 5/6 and 7/8**

### **Tournament Specifics:**

- Teams of 2-5 students with a parent or teacher sponsor are welcome.
- There are three parts to the competition—a group challenge, an individual challenge, and a hands-on challenge.
- A set of paper and pencil questions will be solved in a specified time frame for the group and individual challenges.
- Discussion amongst the team is encouraged for the group event and prohibited for the individual event.
- Sponsors will be in the room but cannot advise or assist students once the challenge begins.
- The hands-on event will be an application question in the style of DI instant challenges. All required materials will be provided to the groups.
- Team scores will be averaged so that larger teams do not have an advantage.
- Take advantage of the hang out space in the cafeteria to relax or regroup between events.
- Concessions will be available for snacks and lunch as participants want them.
- The tournament concludes with an awards ceremony. The top-scoring team in each division and the top scoring individual in each division will win a prize. Additionally, we plan to recognize each participant and the top-scoring student from each team or school.
