- ◆ Scissors
- ◆ 2 – two pocket folders
- ◆ 1 highlighter
- ◆ 10 Elmer's glue sticks
- ◆ 1 box of colored pencils
- ◆ 1 roll of scotch brand masking tape or Duct tape
- ◆ **BOYS-** 1 box of tissues
 - Scotch Tape Clear
 - 1 box of Ziploc bags - Quart size
- ◆ **GIRLS -** 1 box of Ziploc Bags - Gallon size)
 - Index cards or Post-it notes
 - Dry Erase Markers – fat or thin
